ADVISORY BOARD DESCRIPTIONS

Library Board – Members shall be four from the city and fifth from either the city or the county, all appointed by the City Commission. A sixth member may be appointed by the County with approval of the Commission for one year so long as the County allocated funding. Terms are four years. Advance and promote the education and general welfare of the citizens of Tucumcari. Advise in the operation and management of the Tucumcari Public Library.

Lodger's Tax Board – A five-member board shall be appointed by the City Commission that consists of two members who are owners or operators of lodgings subject to the occupancy tax within the municipality, two members who are owners or operators of industries located within the municipality that primarily provide services or products to tourists and one who is a resident of the municipality and represents the general public. The Board shall advise the City Commission on expenditure of funds for advertising, publicizing, and promoting tourist attractions and facilities in the municipalities and surrounding areas.

Memorial Park Cemetery Board – A five-member board appointed by the City Commission shall serve two years. The Board shall act in an advisory capacity and shall advise the City Commission in every possible way to ensure the efficient and economical operation of the Tucumcari Memorial Park Cemetery.

Planning & Zoning Commission – A five-member board appointed by the City Commission shall serve two years. The planning commission's powers and duties include review, action and/or recommendation on certain application and appeals that may come before it for review.

Recreation Board – A seven-member board appointed by the City Commission shall consist of a senior citizen and six other members shall serve three-year terms. The Board shall recommend to the City Commission suitable rules and regulations for the city recreation facility, to ensure the proper operation of the supervised recreation system.

Senior Citizen Board – A five-member board appointed by the City Commission shall serve two years. The Board shall act in an advisory capacity and shall advise the City Commission in every possible way to ensure the efficient and economical operation of the Tucumcari Senior Citizen Center.
