

ORDINANCE 1180

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 897 ADOPTED ON MAY 25, 1995 AND ORDINANCE 1042, ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 9, 2006, PERTAINING TO CHAPTER 2.48, RECREATION BOARD OF THE TUCUMCARI MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TUCUMCARI, NEW MEXICO:

Chapter 2.48.010 of the Tucumcari Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.48.010. ESTABLISHMENT – MEMBERSHIP – TERMS OF OFFICE. For the purpose of creating a supervised recreation system in the city, there is established a city recreation board composed of five (5) members. Members of the board will be appointed by the City Commission, the Governing Body of the City of Tucumcari, after receiving recommendations for appointment from existing board. These appointed members shall be responsible citizens, and residents of the city and Quay County. The first members of the board shall be appointed for the following terms: two members shall be appointed for terms of two years, two members shall be appointed for terms of three years, and the fifth member shall be a senior citizen appointed for a term of two years. Thereafter, the members of the board shall be selected in the same manner as the member he or she is succeeding.

Persons appointed to the board shall serve as a member until the expiration of the term. However, an appointed board member who fails to attend two consecutive meetings, without a valid reason, shall be replaced by a new member.

The board shall elect a chair and a vice-chair who will serve for a calendar year next succeeding his or her election.

Section 2. Section 2.48.020. MEETING TIME - The Recreation Board shall meet once every quarter of the calendar year. Emergency meetings may be called should business come up that needs immediate attention or approval from the board.

Section 3. Section 2.48.030. POWERS AND DUTIES – The Tucumcari Recreation Board shall recommend to the City Commission suitable rules and regulations for the City recreation Facility, to insure the proper operation of a supervised recreation system. These regulations shall be for all City owned and operated City Recreation Facilities, including all playgrounds and ballpark facilities. The board shall make budget recommendations to the City Commission. The minutes of the recreation board will be taken and maintained by City staff and presented to the City Commission for their acknowledgement.

Section 4. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances previously enacted and in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. If any part of this ordinance is declared invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the provisions contained herein.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect five days after final publication following the final passage herein.
